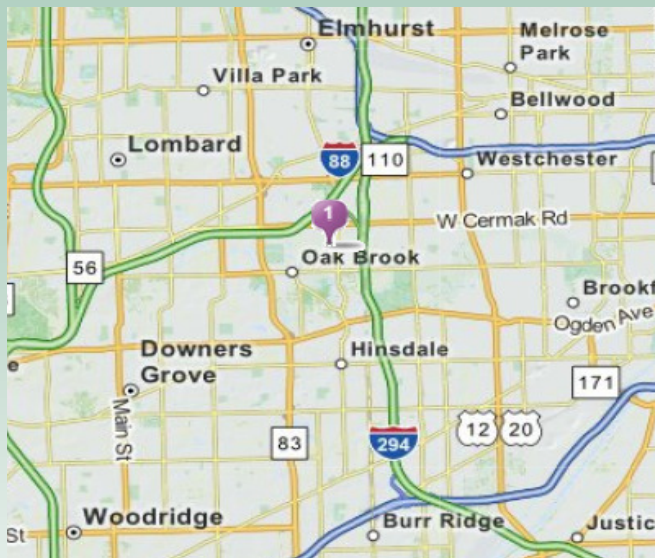
GUEST INFORMATION



Butler National Golf Club is an exclusive private golf club, located in the Western suburb of Oak Brook, Ill. The club has a traditional 18 hole golf course, previously hosting the Western Open tournament. Butler National is a private, members only club with membership by invitation only.

The club hosted the Western Open from 1974 to 1990. The tournament featured some of the games best, including Jack Nicklaus, Tom Watson (Champion in 1974, 1977, and 1984), Hale Irwin (Champion in 1975) and Tom Kite (Champion in 1986). In 1985, an amateur named Scott Verplank was able to hold off the field and claim victory. He is the 2nd amateur to win the Western Open, with the 1st being Chick Evans in 1910.

Golf Digest consistently ranks Butler National among the "Top 100" golf courses in America. In 2012, Golf Digest rated Butler National the nation's 11th-toughest course and No. 1 in Illinois. The member's course rating is 73.9 with a slope of 144, measured at 6,720 yards. The back tees stretch the course to 7,523 yards with a course rating of 78.1 and a slope of 152.



DIRECTIONS:

- From the north, take 294 South, exit 22nd St west to York Rd., turn left & right into entrance.
- From the south, take 294 North, exit Ogden west to York Rd., turn right & left into entrance (after 31st street).
- Approximately 25 minutes from Chicago. Take 290 West to Roosevelt Rd. west, continue & exit York Rd. South, go past 22nd Street and the entrance is on your right.
- **The entrance is shared with Oak Brook G.C., on the west side of York Rd between 22nd & 31st streets.**

DRESS CODE: Gentlemen's golf attire is required on the course and throughout the clubhouse. This attire must include a golf-type shirt, slacks and golf shoes. Shirt tails must be tucked in at all times. Shorts may be worn, but only if they are of traditional Bermuda (knee length) style. Please, no athletic style shorts. Blue jeans are only allowed in transit to/from your locker. When events include dinner, a jacket is required unless otherwise specified. Hats are not to be worn inside clubhouse and shoes are to be non-metal spikes only.

CELL PHONES: Voice usage is allowed in the Cell phone booths, adjacent to the Front foyer. Data usage is allowed in the rear of the Locker rooms.

NO SMOKING: Butler National is a smoke free facility. Smoking will not be permitted inside the Clubhouse nor within 15 feet of any exterior door or window.

UPON ARRIVAL: Let the parking attendant know which member is your host. If you have any questions, please call 630-990-3333 and the front office will be glad to help you.

LOCKERS: The locker room is located on the north end of the building. Please see a Locker Room attendant and he will show you to your locker.

PRACTICE FACILITIES: The driving range, short iron range, chipping area and putting green are available for your use. Please contact the Golf shop or Cad-die Master for directions.
